CALL MEETING TO ORDER

Chair Bill Daneluik called the meeting to order at 6:45 p.m. Everyone was welcomed to the Annual General Meeting and guest introductions were completed.

• Chair Bill Daneluik presented the Chairman's Message, highlighting the successes of the Commission in 2022. A noteworthy success was the Management and Operations contract RFP process, with the City of Leduc Administration team being awarded the successful proponent, agreeing to continue serving the Commission for the next 4-5 years. Chair Bill Daneluik acknowledged the City of Leduc Administration team and Associated Engineering's diligent work in proactively acquiring the \$2.3M from the Water for Life Grant for the Nisku Booster Station project. Chair Daneluik acknowledged the Honourable MLA Rick Wilson & the contribution of the Government of Alberta through the



Water for Life grant. Chair Daneluik noted another highlight is our Administration team finding a solution to the tender challenges with the Beaumont Pipe Upgrade project. This project will now be completed as part of the Nisku Booster Station

I. ADOPTION OF AGENDA

II. APPROVAL OF THE APRIL 21, 2022 ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING MINUTES

Motion: It was **Moved** by Councillor Lars Hansen that the meeting minutes of the April 21, 2022 Capital Region Southwest Water Services Commission Annual General Meeting be approved as circulated.

III. DRAFT 2022 ANNUAL REPORT

Chair Bill Daneluik invited Shawn Olson, Commission Manager, and Rick Sereda, Operations Manager, to present the 2022 Management and Operations Report.

Shawn Olson and Rick Sereda reviewed the Management and Operations Report of the 2022 Annual Report and summarized some of the Commission's accomplishments from 2022.

- Shawn Olson thanked the board for their continued trust and support through the award of the Management and Operations contract last year. An independent review team made recommendations to the board, and the City of Leduc was awarded the Management and Operations Contract. Upon Board request, the City agreed to accept a 4-year term contract with the possibility of a 1-year extension, to avoid contract renewal during the 2025 municipal elections. Shawn thanked the board on behalf of the City of Leduc, and the Administration team, he formally thanked the Board for their continued trust and support.
- Shawn Olson acknowledged how incredibly proud that the Commission was to be awarded \$2.3M of grant funding through the Water for Life program towards the \$21.6M Nisku Booster Station project. Shawn noted the addition of the booster station, the Beaumont piping upgrade was added to the scope of work to use the larger economies of scale to get a more competitive price for the work.



- Rick Sereda spoke about the Board approving a new project for a digital ball camera
 inspection of the Beaumont pipelines to assess the integrity of the pipes and proactively
 plan for repairs and replacements. He noted administration thought it prudent to add a
 chamber around the insertion point and utilize the hot tap as an air relief chamber,
 improving this access point for future inspections and testing activities. The camera
 inspection determined that the Beaumont line is in good condition and there were no noted
 concerns.
- Rick brought forward the lightning strike incident that occurred at the Highway 21 Booster Station which resulted in damage to the communication tower's programmable logic controller (PLC). Administration responded immediately and is pleased to report that the water supply was not impacted or interrupted. Repairs for this incident were completed at the end of 2022.

In closing, Shawn Olson and Rick Sereda recognized the hard work of the City of Leduc Management and Operations team over the past year. Shannon Bremner was recognized for her dedicated service to the Commission from 2016 – 2022, and Katherine O'Dwyer was welcomed as the incoming Commission's Secretary effective as of September 2022. The Administration presented Shannon with a token of appreciation and thanked her for her hard work.

On behalf of the City of Leduc, Shawn Olson and Rick Sereda extended sincere appreciation to the Board and member municipalities for their collaborative working relationship and continued support throughout 2022.

Motion: It was **Moved** by Councillor Kelly-Lynn Lewis that the Draft 2022 Annual Report be accepted as presented.
